Summary of Teaching, Administrative, & Research Skills

- **My skills related to education** include development and evaluation of courses and curricula from the level of community educational programs, to undergraduate college levels, to graduate and post-graduate education (including manuals and instruction in Spanish); development and evaluation of testing procedures; the evaluation of individual teachers and teaching techniques; and field supervision including observation and reflection (both within groups and one-on-one) on more effective health promotion methods and techniques for health promoters.
- **My administrative skills** include budget and personnel management of clinical care facilities; and skills related to competitive grants include grant writing, budget management, and program monitoring and evaluation.
- **My research-related skills** for clinical and qualitative research include protocol development (including randomized clinical trials), survey design and validation, statistical planning and analysis, evaluating human subject protection and ethical issues, participant recruitment and follow-up, safety monitoring, data management, and manuscript composition.

My professional teaching experiences began as a senior medical student teaching a group of second-year physical diagnosis students and has continued throughout my life, including more than 10 years at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine (UCCOM) as an attending faculty physician, as well as teaching health workers and community health promoters in programs in the Dominican Republic for more than 13 years.

Instructional venues have included traditional classroom settings, informal seminars, small group discussions, clinical rounds, simulations, supervision of procedures and other "hands-on" techniques, and field supervision of community health workers and graduate students.

University-based teaching activities included direct instruction of undergraduate students (Honors Topic courses in the University of Cincinnati Honors Scholars Program), of medical students at all levels within the College of Medicine (including serving on the Year-Two Curriculum Committee, ad hoc curriculum development committees, and as Block Coordinator for Introduction to Clinical Practice for both the Pulmonary/Critical Care and Infectious Diseases content, UCCOM, of graduate students (within the College of Medicine in both the Biostatistics/Epidemiology and Internal Medicine Departments, as well as students from other Colleges within the University such as Geography and Nursing), of post-graduate intern and resident physicians, of fellows within the Department of Internal Medicine, and of professional peers through intramural and extramural conferences. Non-university activities have included adult and adolescent education in seminar and workshop formats in the USA and the Dominican Republic to train community health workers, peer-educators, and HIV/AIDS volunteers.
